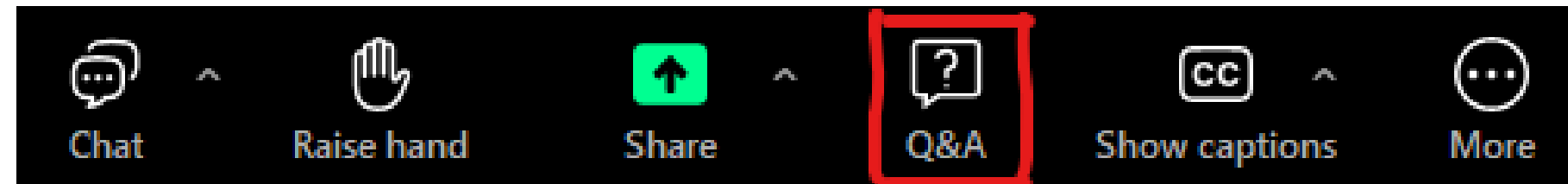

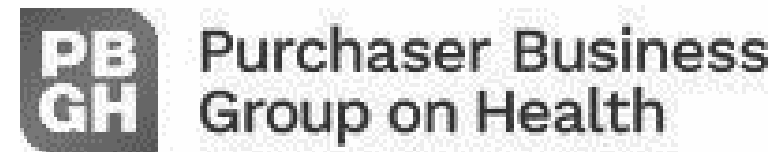
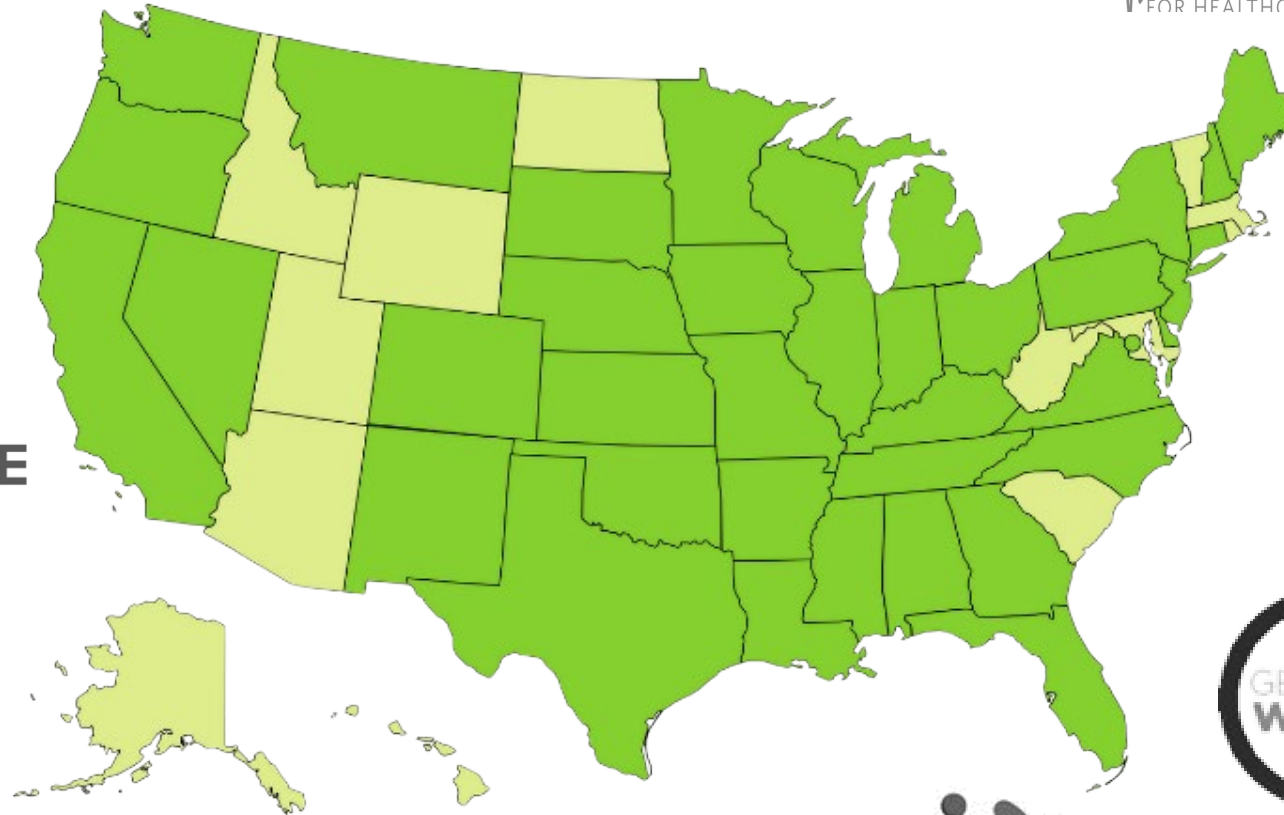

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Leapfrog ASC Advisory Committee

The ASC Advisory Committee advises Leapfrog on key issues related to ASC safety, quality, and efficiency to ensure that employers have the best available data for decision-making.

The Committee was an integral part of the new ASC Public Reporting Program, and the ASC Survey 2.0, as Leapfrog overhauled our reporting to ensure so every patient receiving care in an ASC can access the same life-saving information about patient safety and quality that has long been available for inpatient hospital care.

New in 2026: ASC Public Reporting Program

Leapfrog's ASC Public Reporting Program:

A Journey of Progressive Transparency to Improve Patient Outcomes

CMS Public Reporting

As a starting point, ASCs that participate in the CMS ASCQR program can point to Leapfrog's public reporting website for patients, employers, purchasers, and health plans who have questions about their safety and quality.

Submit the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0

Finally, ASCs that commit to voluntary reporting on evidence-based measures of critical importance to consumers and purchasers, can demonstrate their commitment to full transparency and earn recognition on Leapfrog's public reporting website and through Leapfrog's Top ASC designation.

Upload Accreditation Certificate for Public Reporting

Next, ASCs that upload documentation of their AAAHC or Joint Commission accreditation can additionally build trust by having even more patient safety information on Leapfrog's public reporting website.

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Make CMS ASCQR Data More Accessible to Consumers and Purchasers

- This year Leapfrog will score and publicly report 13 measures from the CMS Ambulatory Surgery Center Quality Reporting (ASCQR) Program on our public reporting website to ensure that patients and family caregivers have a place to easily search for and compare facilities.
- ASCs will be scored using benchmarks established by assessing the distribution of performance for all ASCs participating in the ASCQR program, and their progress will be publicly reported on a four-level scale ranging from Achieved the Standard (best score) to Limited Achievement (worst score).
- **These scores will be publicly reported for ALL ASCs in the provider data catalog and have data publicly available for at least one of the ASC 1-4 measures.**
- Visitors to Leapfrog's public reporting website will be able to select up to three facilities to compare side-by-side.

Highlight National Accreditation Standards

- ASCs with active accreditation through the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC) or Joint Commission's (JC) programs will be scored and publicly reported as Achieved the Standard (best score) for 5 measures:
 - Clinicians Certified in Advanced Life Support Always Present
 - Use of a Safe Surgery Checklist
 - Medication and Allergy Documentation
 - Leadership Structures and Systems to Support Patient Safety
 - Identification and Mitigation of Patient Safety Risks
- ASCs are required to provide basic demographic information and upload proof of AAAHC or JC Accreditation on Leapfrog's ASC Dashboard.
- ASCs that do not upload proof of accreditation and ASCs that are accredited by another organization will be reported as "Not Available" for the five measures.
- Visitors to our [website](#) will be able to see achievement of these important patient safety standards that ASCs have earned through their rigorous accreditation process.

Score and Publicly Report 8 Measures for ASCs that Voluntarily Submit the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0

- The ASC Survey 2.0 maintains 8 measures not available from any other source:
 - **Patients' Rights and Ethics:** Billing Ethics, Health Care Equity, Informed Consent, Taking Responsibility for Never Events
 - **Patient Safety Practices:** Infection Surveillance Following Breast Surgeries, Laminectomies, Herniorrhaphies, or Knee Prosthesis Procedures, Hand Hygiene, Culture of Safety
 - **Volume of Procedures:** National Volume Standards for Total Knee Replacement, Total Hip Replacement, and Bariatric Surgery for Weight Loss; Facility Volume for Select Procedures (Optional)
- Ensures purchasers, employers, and the health plans they work with have the information they need to drive value-based purchasing strategies including direct contracting and preferred networks, and consumers have critical information unavailable elsewhere.
- We anticipate that ASCs will need to commit about 10 hours of staff time for data collection and reporting; this is a 50% reduction from previous years.

It's Never Been Easier to Submit the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0

ASC Survey 2.0: 50% reduction in time to submit

- Over 50 Survey questions removed; remaining measures streamlined to better align with ASC care, including updates to Hand Hygiene, Culture of Safety, and Informed Consent
- **Just 10 hours** of staff time needed to complete

Newly Optional: Volume of Procedures Reporting

- Directly addressed the most challenging obstacle to submitting the ASC Survey
- Now even ASCs with paper-based records can submit

How Transparency Works for You

- Negotiate with employers, purchasers, and health plans
 - Employers are interested in leveraging data to get the best value for their health care dollars. Some work directly with ASCs, while others contract with health plans or other administrators to design their health care benefits programs. They expect transparent data on safety and quality.
- Benchmark to galvanize improvement
 - We know that transparency makes change possible, and that public reporting provides ASC leaders with an actionable tool to get their team on board. Accountability builds and sustains momentum for quality improvement.
- Demonstrate your commitment to patient safety

 - ASC-1: Percentage of Patients Who Experience a Burn Prior to Discharge from the ASC
 - ASC-2: Percentage of Patients Who Experience a Fall Within the ASC
 - ASC-3: Percentage of Patients Who Experience a Wrong Site, Side, Patient, Procedure or Implant
 - ASC-4: Percentage of ASC Patients Who Are Transferred or Admitted to a Hospital Upon Discharge from the ASC
 - ASC-12: Rate of Unplanned Hospital Visits After an Outpatient Colonoscopy
 - ASC-14 Rate of Unplanned Additional Eye Surgery After Cataract Surgery*
 - ASC-17: Rate of Hospital Visits After Orthopedic Ambulatory Surgical Center Procedures
 - ASC-18: Rate of Hospital Visits After Urology Ambulatory Surgical Center Procedures
 - ASC-19: Rate of Unplanned Hospital Visits After General Ambulatory Surgical Center Procedures*

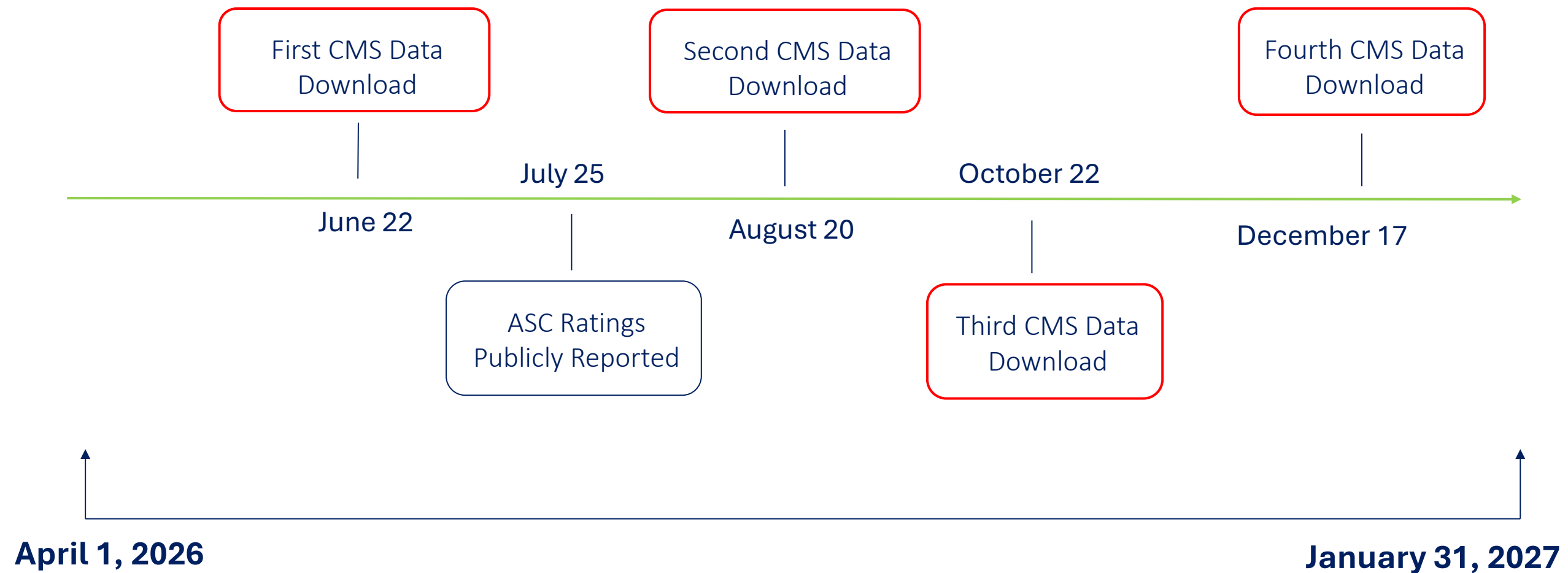

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How to Request a Security Code

Each ambulatory surgery center will need a 16-digit security code to log into the ASC Dashboard and submit the Accreditation Certificate and the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0.

To ensure that only authorized individuals have access to the ASC Dashboard for each facility, a Security Code Request Form must be completed. There are two options for requesting a security code:

Option 1: Submit Your Business License

- Obtain a copy of the facility's national accreditation letter or certificate, or the facility's county or state business license
- Have the Facility Administrator complete and sign the Security Code Request Form
- Print the Security Code Request Form on letterhead
- [Submit a request to the Help Desk](#) with the required documentation in the Attachments field.

Option 2: NHSN Administrator Submits the Request

- Have the individual listed as the "NHSN Administrator" complete and sign the Security Code Request Form
- Print the Security Code Request Form on letterhead

ASCs with active accreditation through the AAAHC or JC can be scored and publicly reported as Achieved the Standard (best score) for the five (5) measures listed below:

- Clinicians Certified in Advanced Life Support Always Present
- Use of a Safe Surgery Checklist
- Medication and Allergy Documentation
- Leadership Structures and Systems to Support Patient Safety
- Identification and Mitigation of Patient Safety Risks

ASCs are required to respond to the questions below and upload proof of AAAHC or JC accreditation.

4. After selecting “Upload” confirm that your accreditation certificate has been uploaded successfully by verifying a green banner and check box are shown in the prompt window indicating “File for Facility Name has been uploaded” and your accreditation certificate can be downloaded by clicking the hyperlinked file name.
5. Close out of the “Upload File” prompt window by clicking the “X” in the top right corner.

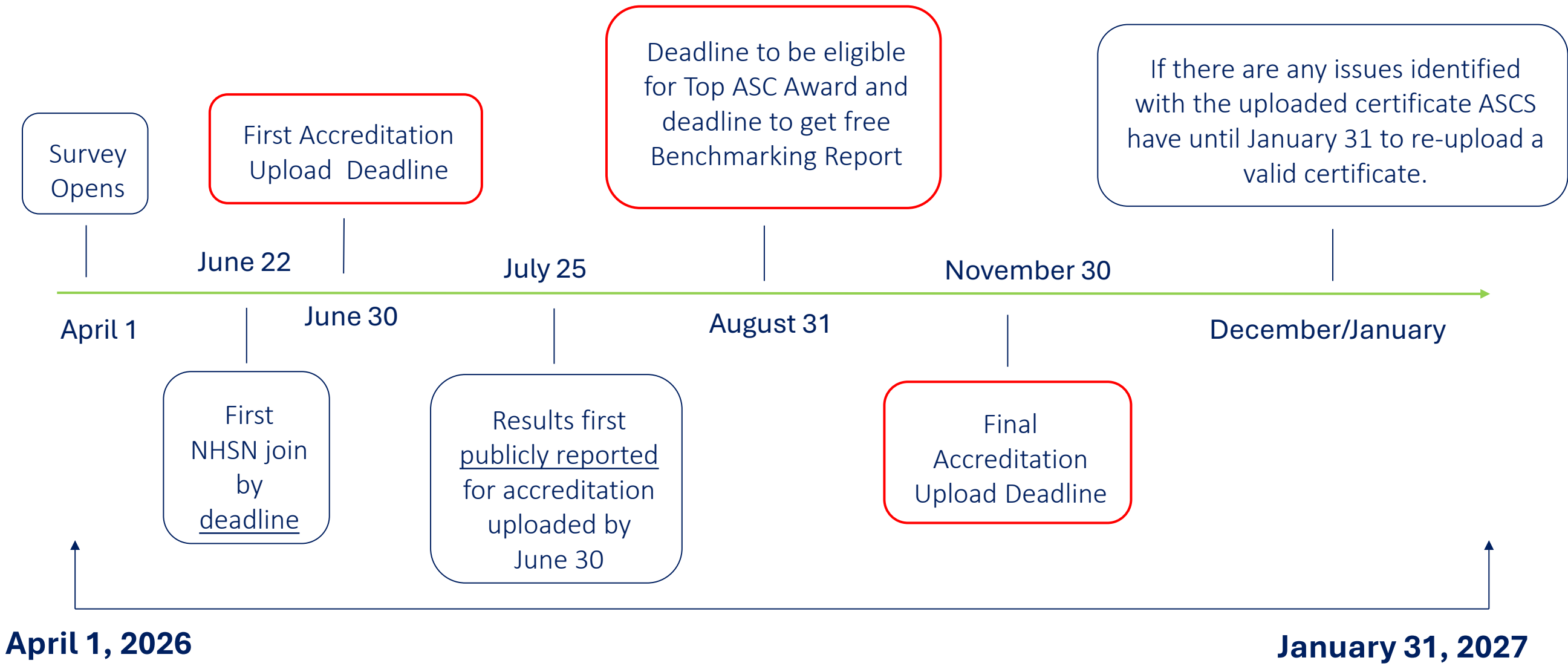

How to Request a Security Code

Each ambulatory surgery center will need a 16-digit security code to log into the ASC Dashboard and submit the Accreditation Certificate and the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0.

To ensure that only authorized individuals have access to the ASC Dashboard for each facility, a Security Code Request Form must be completed. There are two options for requesting a security code:

- Each year facilities must complete an ASC Profile to provide demographic and contact information to Leapfrog.
- Each section of the Survey is organized in the same format in the hard copy of the ASC Survey 2.0 and the ASC Dashboard:
 - **General information** about The Leapfrog Group’s standard (hard copy only).
 - **Reporting periods** to provide facilities with specific periods of time for each set of questions.
 - **Survey questions** which may include references to endnotes. The Survey questions and endnotes match the Online ASC Survey Tool exactly.
 - **Affirmation of accuracy** by your facility’s administrator or by an individual that has been designated by your facility’s administrator. These statements affirm the accuracy of your ASC’s responses.
 - **Reference Information** which includes ‘What’s New’ and ‘Change Summaries,’ important measure specifications, answers to frequently asked questions, and other notes that must be carefully reviewed before providing responses to any of the Survey questions (included in the hard copy only).

Section 1: Basic Facility Information

- Provide general facility information, such as:
 - Number of operating rooms
 - Number of endoscopic procedure rooms
 - Number of adult and pediatric discharges
 - Teaching status
 - Ownership
 - EHR use
 - Managing Patient-Reported Concerns

Section 2: Patient Rights and Ethics

- Billing Ethics
 - Transparent billing, no legal action against patients without prior written agreement
- Health Care Equity
 - Collect self-identified demographic data and analyze disparities in quality of care
- Informed Consent
 - Training, complete and readable consent forms, use teach back method and interpreters
- Taking Responsibility for Never Events
 - Apologize to patients after a never event, waive costs, and take steps to ensure it can't happen again

Section 3: Patient Safety Practices

- Infection Surveillance following Breast Surgeries, Laminectomies, Herniorrhaphies, or Knee Prosthesis Procedures
 - SSI Reporting Plan available in NHSN for all applicable procedures
- Hand Hygiene (*reduced questions from 2025*)
 - Training and Education, Infrastructure, Monitoring, Feedback and Culture
- Culture of Safety (*reduced questions from 2025*)
 - Administering a culture of safety survey and using the results in staff education, performance improvement

Section 4: National Volume Standards for Total Knee Replacement, Total Hip Replacement, and Bariatric Surgery for Weight Loss

- Total Knee Replacement, Total Hip Replacement, Bariatric Surgery for Weight Loss
 - Meeting facility and surgeon volume standards
- Facility Volume for Select Procedures (*now optional*)
 - Reporting on the volume of procedures your facility performs

Pre-Submission Checklist

- **Visit the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0 website pages at <http://www.leapfroggroup.org/asc>.**
- **Make sure you have a 16-digit security code.** If you don't, download a [Security Code Request](#) form.
- **Download a hard copy of the Survey** (PDF or Word document) on the [ASC Survey 2.0 webpage](#). Read through the [entire Survey document](#) to ensure that you understand what information is required.
- **Review the reference information** in each section of the Survey document and **download [other supporting materials](#)**. These documents and tools contain information that you will need to accurately respond to the Survey questions.
- **Accept the American Medical Association's Terms of Use and Download the CPT Code Workbook.** While volume reporting in Section 4B is optional, ASCs must report on Section 4A: National Volume Standards for Total Hip Replacements, Total Knee Replacements, and Bariatric Surgery for Weight Loss, if applicable. Prior to completing Section 4, ASCs must accept the American Medical Association's Terms of Use and download the CPT Code Workbook via the button in Section 4 of the Online Survey Tool. Please note, if you are part of a network, each ASC will need to individually complete the Terms of Use. This is a requirement of the American Medical Association.
- **Join Leapfrog's NHSN Group.** ASCs reporting on Section 3A: Infection Surveillance following Breast Surgeries, Laminectomies, Herniorrhaphies, or Knee Prosthesis Procedures are required to join Leapfrog's NHSN Group (The Leapfrog Group – ASCs Group ID: 57193) in order for Leapfrog to download the data used in scoring. Download the instructions and review information about deadlines on the [Join NHSN Group webpage](#).
- **Identify individuals from your ASC to help you** gather the data you will need to complete the various sections of the Survey.

Pre-Submission Checklist (Continued)

- **Complete a hard copy of the Survey before you enter responses into the Online ASC Survey Tool.** This will expedite data entry into the Online ASC Survey Tool and help to avoid the Tool “timing out” after 20 minutes of idle time (a security precaution). Once all the information has been collected and recorded in the hard copy of the Survey, the Administrator or the Administrator’s designee can typically complete the data entry online in less than an hour. Please note, responses must be entered into the Online Survey Tool to be submitted.
- **Download and review a copy of the ASC Dashboard Guide** on the [Get Started webpage](#). This document includes important instructions on how to navigate the ASC Dashboard and Online ASC Survey Tool, including instructions on how to upload your accreditation certification, verify your ASC has successfully submitted the Survey, and update contact information for your facility.
- **Check Submission deadlines.** Carefully review submission [deadlines](#) before you begin. Ensure that you have enough time to collect the data, complete a hard copy of the Survey, and complete and submit via the Online ASC Survey Tool. Make sure you have joined Leapfrog’s NHSN Group by the appropriate [deadline](#).
- **Download and review the Leapfrog ASC Public Reporting Program [Scoring Algorithms](#),** which include the scoring algorithms that apply to measures in the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0.
- **Review Leapfrog’s policies and procedures regarding data accuracy.** Detailed information can be found on the [Data Accuracy webpage](#).
- **Review Accreditation Standards and upload accreditation certificate on ASC Dashboard.** ASCs are required to respond to the accreditation questions in the ASC Profile. ASCs that select “Yes” and upload proof of their AAAHC or JC accreditation will be reported as “Achieved the Standard” for the five measures. ASCs that select “No” or “Other” or do not upload proof of accreditation from one of these two organizations will be reported as “Not Available” for the five measures.

Leapfrog's Approach to Scoring



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Review the Scoring Algorithms that will be used for Public Reporting of your 2026 Data

- The ASC Public Reporting Program Scoring Algorithms document includes scoring details for each measure from the CMS ASCQR Program, national accreditation standards, and data collected via ASC Survey 2.0.
- Leapfrog publicly reports Survey Results beginning on July 25.
- Facilities that submit an ASC Survey 2.0 by June 30 will be able to preview their Survey Results on the ASC Details Page beginning July 12.
- ASCs should review their Survey Results periodically to ensure accuracy and completeness on our website at <https://ratings.leapfroggroup.org>.

CMS ASCQR & Accreditation Verification

- **CMS ASCQR Data:** Prior to each release, data due to be displayed are made available to providers for a 30-day preview period approximately two months in advance of being made available to the public on data.cms.gov. **Therefore, Leapfrog does not perform any additional data verification on the CMS ASCQR measures.**
- **Accreditation:** Accreditation certificates are reviewed monthly by Leapfrog's Help Desk. **If there are any issues identified with the uploaded certificate, the contacts listed in the ASC Profile will be contacted via email within the first 7 business days of the month following the upload.** If the issues are not resolved by the end of the month, the results for the 5 measures will be updated from "Achieved the Standard" to "Pending Leapfrog Verification" until a current, valid certificate has been re-uploaded.

How ASC Public Reporting Program Results Are Used





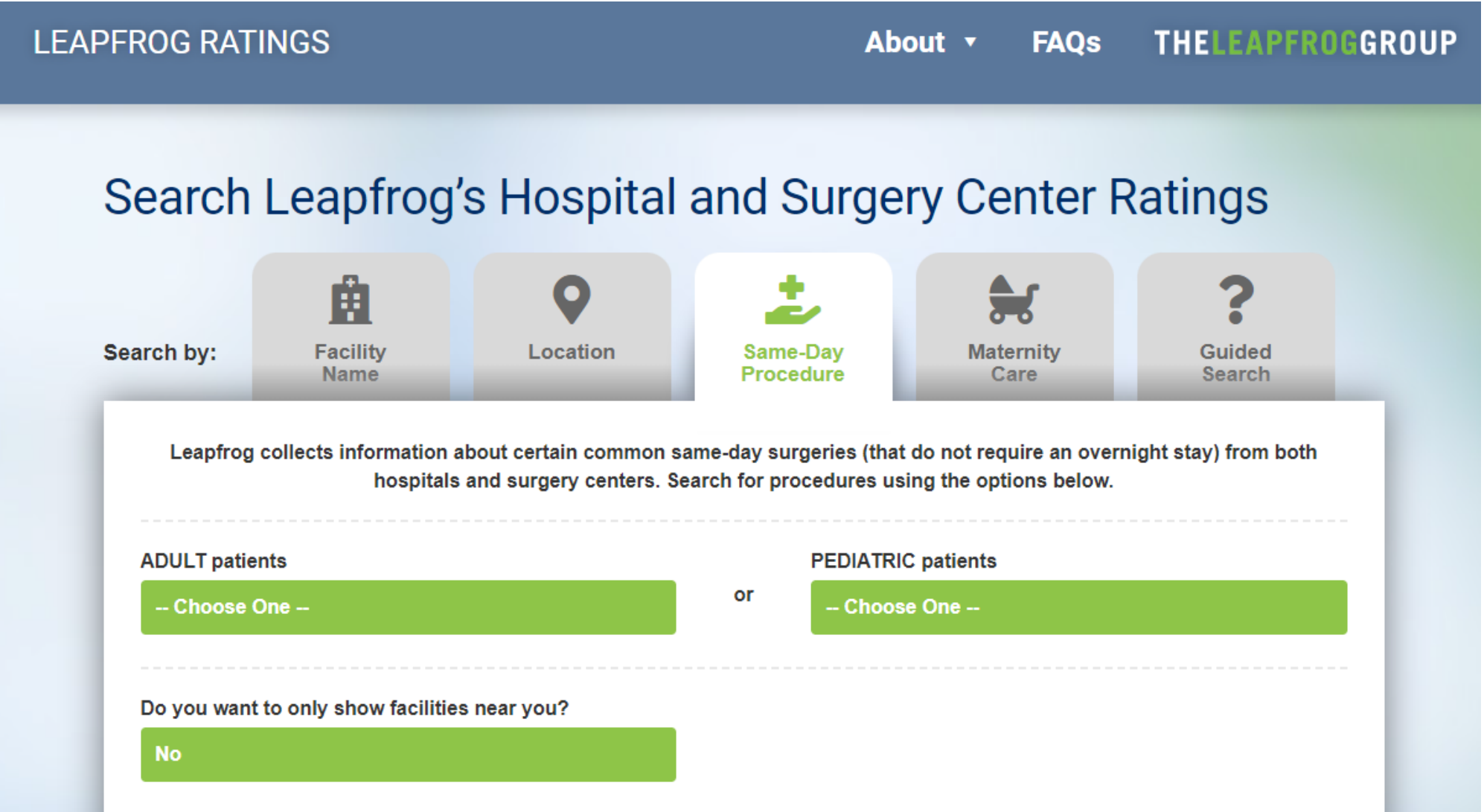

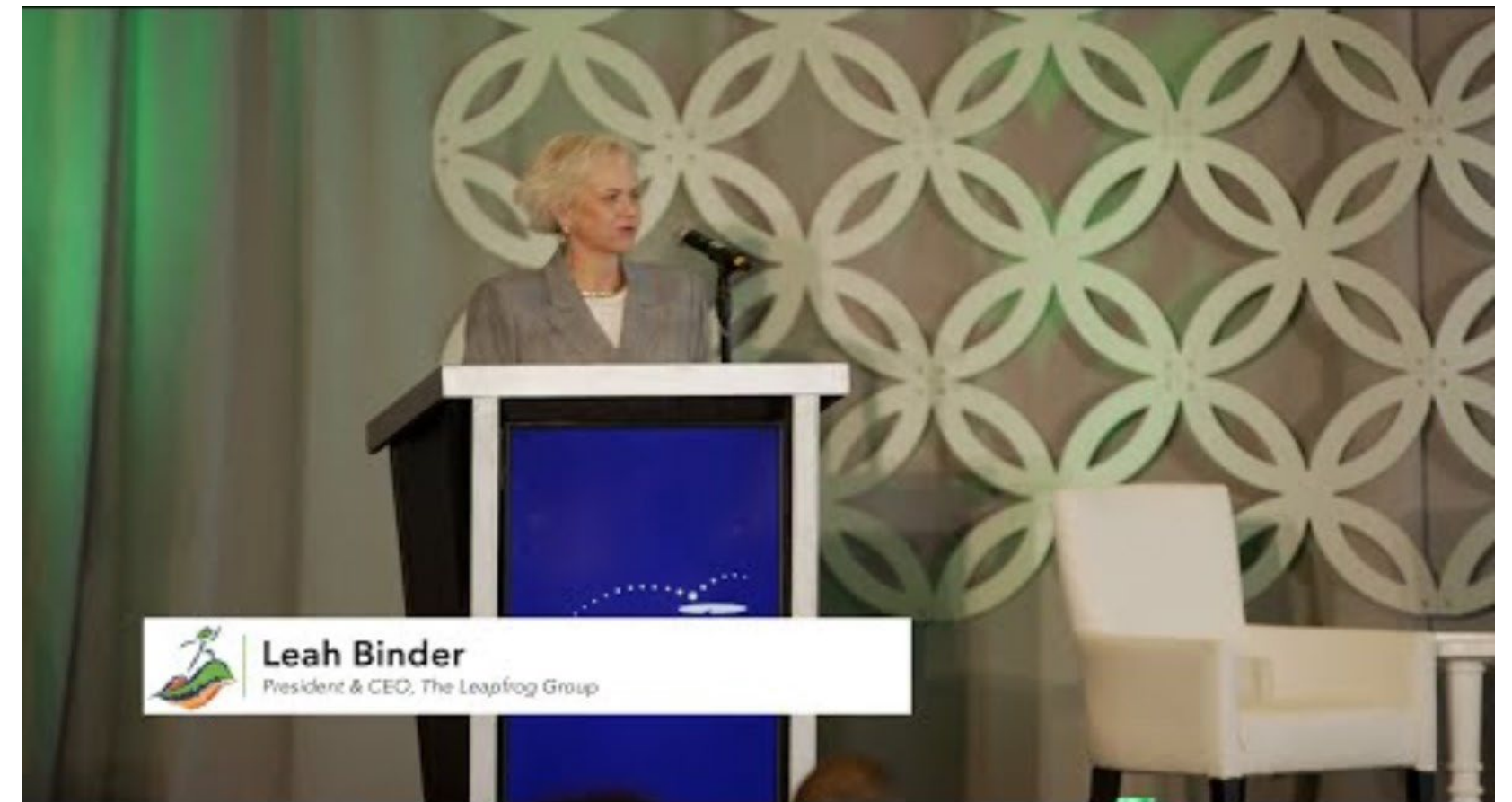

- The report includes:
 - Summary of overall performance.
 - Detailed information on each of the measures included in the Leapfrog ASC Survey 2.0.
 - An appendix that includes surgical volume benchmarks.
- Scores and benchmarking information included in the report are not publicly reported by Leapfrog, but ASCs may choose to share this report internally with staff and leadership.

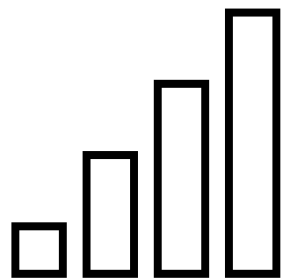

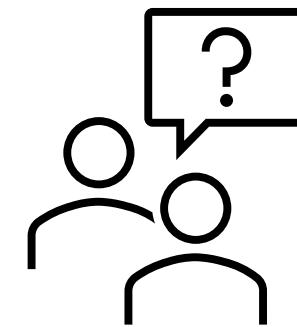

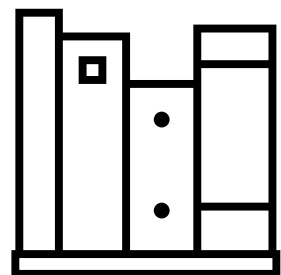
